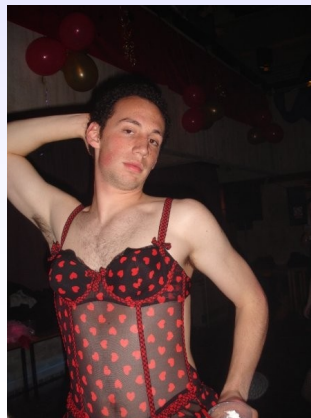


ALISTAIR HODGSON FOR ENTZ CO-ORDINATOR
